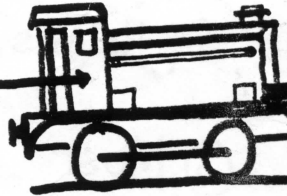

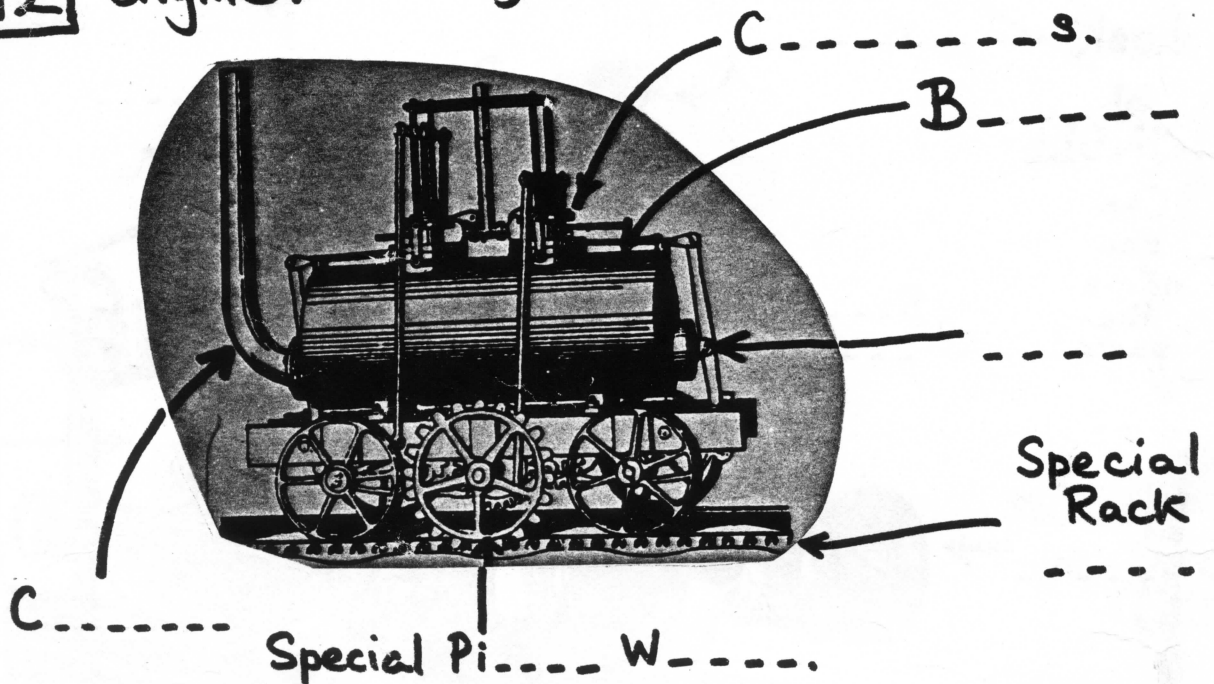

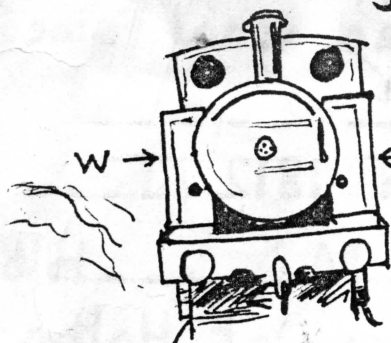

Our engines have all served in mines and works, and are TANK engines - like Thomas and Percy! - Can you fill this in?

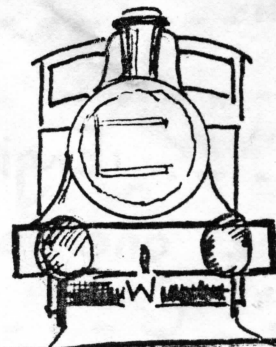
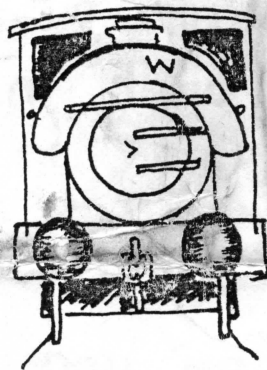


① This engine is a SIDE TANK, built in 1891.

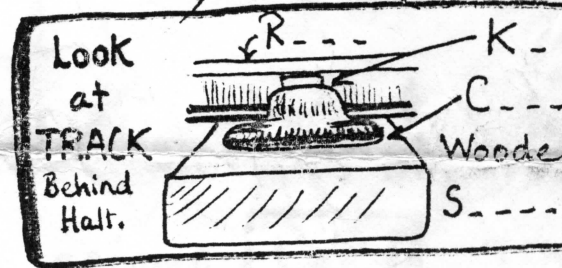
The number is - - - -

② More modern - built in DATE is our blue engine - NAME - This is a WELL TANK built in St. Helens.

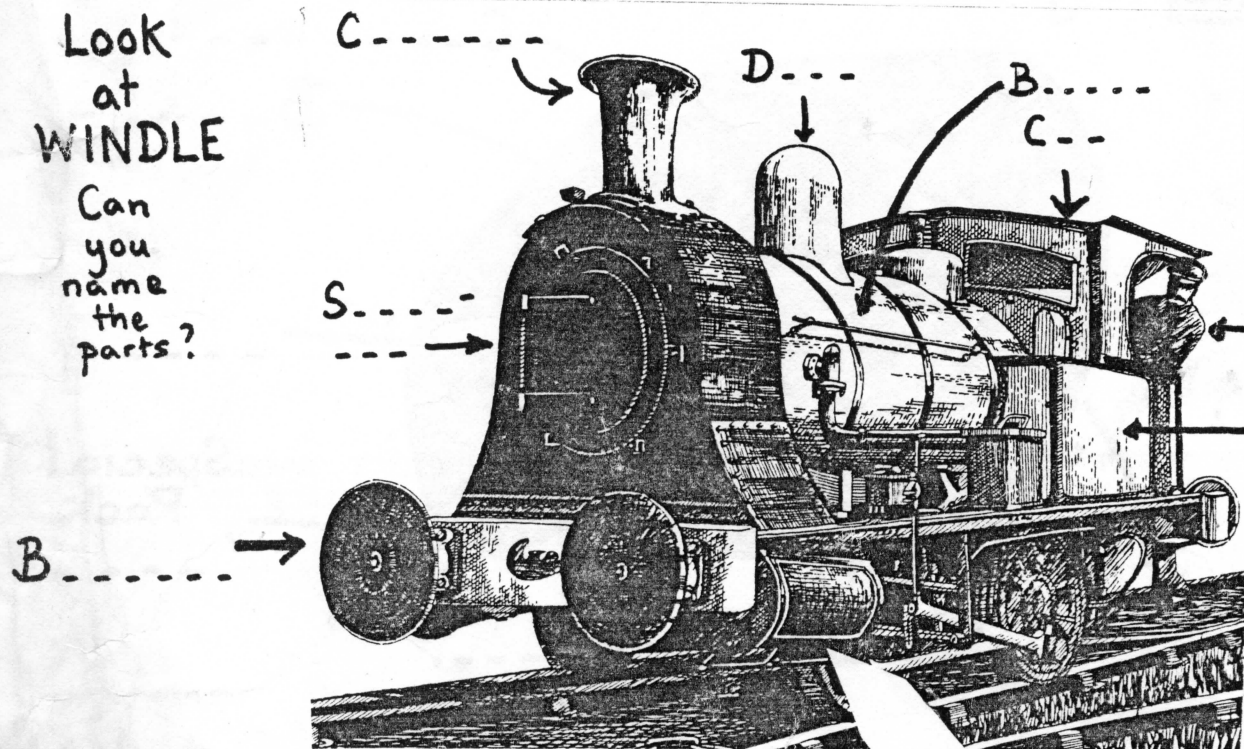


③ Most modern is our dark green SADDLE TANK built in DATE (little cab-side plate)
